Suggested Clothing List:

-Sleeping Bag or Bed clothing

-Pillow

In addition to clothes worn when arrives:

-2 Pr. Jeans or britches

-2 Short sleeve Shirts

-Sweat shirt or sweater

-2 long sleeve shirts

-3 pr. underwear

-4 pair socks

-Night clothing

-Paddock Boots, riding boots, or lace up shoes with (preferably smooth sole) and one inch heel.

-Tennis shoes

-Warm Jacket

-SEI approved hard hat (if have, otherwise we will provide)

-2 pair gloves, suitable for riding: no mittens, reasonably close fitting, warm.

-Hat: warm for winter, with bill for sunny times

-Rain Jacket (not poncho)

Please keep in mind that this is only a SUGGESTED clothing list; will need balancing for weather differences. For instance, two short sleeve shirts may not be needed in Nov., and Late May groups may want to add in a bathing suit if it looks unseasonably warm. If you have questions, please call ahead. Please remember when packing that you and/or your child will be spending a large amount of time outside. Prepare to dress for the weather, be it cold, hot or rainy.....even with an indoor, we still have to get there!
