Suggested Clothing List:

- Sleeping Bag or Bedding
- Pillow
- Towel
- Jeans
- Warm shirts that you can layer....long sleeve t-shirt or turtle neck; Great time to invest in your polyester or smart wool under layer garments for light fitting layering
- Sweatshirts, sweaters or 100 weight polar fleece.
- Underwear
- Socks light and several heavy wool or polar fleece pair for layering
- Something to sleep in
- Warm jacket. Might want to bring 2: one polar fleece or something that doesn't rustle for riding, and out water proof layer for snow play.
- Warm Hat
- Snow pants
- Snow Boots
- Additional riding boots; Paddock boots or riding boot are fine, OR if you have a pair of slightly larger boots (not traditional snow boots, those are TOO large) that have a smooth sole, lace up and one inch heel, those are preferred if they are insulated or larger enough for additional socks.
- Several pair of gloves. One pair should not be mittens, warm and snug fitting for riding. Waterproof gloves are lousy for riding.....great for snow sports!
- Long johns; won't be able to ride in snow pants.
- Sweats
- Slippers
- SEI approved helmet (if have, otherwise, will supply)

Please keep in mind that this is a SUGGESTED Packing list. I have added no amounts, since it depends on your camper's stay. If they do not plan on riding, of course those items would not needed. Please also note: Kids in snow get wet. Clothes will take awhile to dry, impeding any further outdoor play until they are dry. Cotton DRIES SLOW!!!! Polyester, smart wool, nylon or blends of the above dry quickly and stay warm even when wet. Additionally, they pack in half the size. This may be a great time to consider investing. Save the cotton for inside endeavors.

Please Remember:

- Your camper will be spending a large amount of time outside. Pack for layering warmth.
- Snow melts. Kids get wet.....so do clothes. Kids will want to go back outside before everything is dry. Pack extras.
- There are many kids here besides yours. It is NOT a good place for valuable toys, electronics, jewelry, etc. Things break. We will not be held responsible for loss or damage.
- We will feed them lots. We have animals that steal. Please do not send extra food. We will keep your camper well fed.
