An advance deposit of **\$100.00** for each week reserved must accompany this application. The balance of the tuition is due by **June 1st 2012**. Payment plans available. This tuition includes room, board, laundry, basic riding and all camp activities taken place on the camp grounds. One week campers are accepted all weeks. To get the full advantage of the **CEDAR LODGE** structure, we recommend a minimum of two weeks.

Camp Fees include 2-1 hour riding sessions each week. This is an introduction to horsemanship for those campers who plan on doing just a little bit of riding while at **CEDAR LODGE**.

_____ **Camper Horse Board** - Camper boarded horses; \$170.00/week. Price includes board and full riding program fee as long as horse is used by camper in riding class. Contact for more information.

CEDAR LODGE POLICY on Payments, Cancellations, Early and Late Arrivals:

Refunds will be made as funds are available and no later than the beginning of camp.

Until March 31st: Any payments made, less \$100.00 cancellation fee is refundable.

From April 1st to June 1st: Deposit is non refundable. All other payments made, less a \$100.00 cancellation fee (in addition to deposit amount) are refundable.

After **June 1st:** **No** refunds for cancellations or no shows.

-Payment must be paid in full by June 1st. Payment plans available upon request.

-A fee of **\$25.00** will be billed for all returned checks.

-Any Applications that are posted after June 1st **must be accompanied by payment in full.**

-There will be no refunds made for a camper leaving camp during any camp session, including for reasons of homesickness, except with the written verification of a physician of an injury or physical illness AND if the director and camp physician agree it is in the child's and camp's best interest that the child leave camp.

-There will be no refund for early departure if a parent decides to remove their son or daughter from camp against the director's advice.

-Any camper or staff member found using alcohol, marijuana, or non-prescribed drugs on the camp's grounds or on field trips will be sent home immediately. No refunds will be issued. Any prescribed medication that a camper brings to camp must be given to the Camp Health Director.

-There is no reduction in fees for those campers arriving late or leaving early. In case of serious illness or injury, one half of the non-expired camp fee will be refunded.

DISCOUNTS ON SUMMER CAMP FEES:

Siblings:

If more than one child attends Cedar Lodge from the same family, each additional child will receive a 5% discount on camp fees.

Early Registrations:

Applications received before December 15, 2011 paid in full receive a 10% discount.

Applications received before January 15th, 2012 paid in full receive a 5% discount.

Applications received with deposit by January 15th, 2012 and paid in full by April 15th receive a 3% discount.

PLEASE NOTE:

Camp Discounts as stated above do not apply to Riding Program fees!

Foods: Meals at Cedar Lodge are served family style, and are nutritious and ample. Milk is served every day along with a substitute beverage. Salads and fresh fruits are always available. A vegetarian substitute is available for those desiring a no-meat diet, **but** those campers on a full vegetarian diet must be so-noted on the "special needs" form.

Medical: Cedar Lodge maintains a full time medical officer on the camp staff to take care of the daily medical needs of all campers. There is no charge for this service. Camp families are responsible for any additional medical expense incurred by their camper due to illness or accident while at camp. We require the information of your insurance carrier and policy number on our Camp Health Form.

Lost and Found Policy: At the end of each summer season, we are left with a large amount of unclaimed towels, t-shirts, socks, etc., most without names. Cedar Lodge's "Lost and Found Policy" requires a \$10.00 service charge for parents that want their children's belongings mailed back to them. This fee is due when your camper arrives at camp.
