

2022 Cedar Lodge pre-camp COVID requirements

Dear Camp Families,

By recommendations from the state of Michigan and ACA we are requiring all campers and staff to adhere to the following COVID protocol

- 1) If you are vaccinated: Please supply us with a copy of your vaccination if your camper is 5 years and up including booster shot date.
- 2) All campers regardless of vaccination will be required to have a PCR test 48-72 hours before their camp arrival. This MUST be a PCR test. No rapid test will be allowed as a substitute.
- 3) All campers will be required to have a rapid test on their arrival to camp.

Please practice self quarantine after the test is given until your camper's arrival at camp. If you are having difficulty please contact us.

IF: Your camper has tested positive for COVID within 90 days of camp, please send us a photo copy of his positive test. They will be responsible for testing negative on two rapid tests within 72 hours of arrival to camp at least 24 hours apart. Photograph negative test and date/time and send to us at campcedarlodge@gmail.com . We will give a third test at arrival. If cause for cancellation Cedar Lodge will do what they can to accommodate change of dates to later times during the summer.

IF: Your camper has had exposure to someone with COVID with in 10 days of camp, please contact us.

If your camper will be coming for multiple weeks during the summer please rapid test 48-72 hours before arrival at camp again with a photo showing date/time and test results. They will additionally be rapid tested when they arrive at camp.
